March 24 @ 9am (Shells and St. John) - Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

- We recall Jesus' entry into Jerusalem that turns quickly to shouts of "Crucify."
- March 25 @ 7pm (Shells) Monday of Holy Week On this day the Church recalls Mary Magdalene anointing Jesus' feet.
- March 26 @ 7pm (Shells) Tuesday of Holy Week On this day the Church recalls Judas being named as Jesus' betrayer.
- March 27 @ Noon (Shells) Corporate Confession and Forgiveness We gather to confess our sins in preparation for the celebration of the Great Three Days.
- March 27 @ 7pm (Shells) Wednesday of Holy Week On this day the Church recalls the betrayal of Jesus.
- March 28 @ 4pm (St. John) and 7pm (Shells) Holy/Maundy Thursday

We gather to begin the Great Three Days with the celebration of the institution of the Holy Eucharist.

March 29 @ Noon - Stations of the Cross

We will pray at the stations in the Sanctuary with music.

March 29 @ 4pm (St. John) 7pm (Shells) - Liturgy of the Lord's Passion We will remember our Lord's death on the cross and offer our prayers of thanksgiving.

March 30 @ 7pm (Shells) - Easter Vigil

We will gather outside to light the new fire and illumine the darkness with the light of Christ and the promise of salvation. This liturgy is the culmination of the entire liturgical year complete with baptisms, confirmations, and the reception of new members.

March 31 @ 6:45am (Shells) - Easter Sunday Morning Prayer at Sunrise We will gather to celebrate the resurrection in the pavilion.

March 31 @ 9am (Shells and St. John) - Easter Sunday: The Resurrection of the Lord
