SHELLS MUSIC MINISTRY

The Sundays after Epiphany began with Jesus' Baptism and end with the Transfiguration of Our Lord. We sing "Shine, Jesus, Shine, fill this land with the Father's glory; blaze, Spirit, blaze, set our hearts on fire." The Transfiguration of Our Lord is the last Sunday before Lent. Alleluia is bid farewell on this Sunday and will not be used until Easter. Our music during this time reflect the themes of light, baptism, cross and discipleship.

On February 22, Ash Wednesday, we begin our Lenten journey. The Senior Choir is working on psalmody and choral offerings, enhancing and leading the congregation in worship. An invitation to join choir and share in our music ministry is extended to Senior High youth through adults – please join us! **Senior Choir** rehearses **Thursday** evenings from **7:00 – 8:15pm**.

Our *Children In Worship* Sunday School music program continues for our children in preschool through sixth grade, providing opportunities for them to share in worship in many ways. The children learn music for *Shells Bells*, scripture readings with rhythm instruments and new songs for worship. *Shells Bells* play and learn music as part of the Sunday school opening each week. The children will be participating in worship on **February 5**.

Our Children & Youth Handchime Choir for grades 2nd through senior high youth continues with rehearsals the **first and third Sunday** of each month from **10:30 – 11:00am**. Financial Q&A from the Finance Committee

I am withdrawing funds from my IRA and would like to direct some to Shells Lutheran Church. How can I do it?

If you are 70 ½ and are withdrawing funds from your Traditional IRA to satisfy your required minimum distribution, you may want to consider a Qualified Charitable Distribution ("QCD").

A QCD is a direct transfer of funds from your IRA custodian, payable to a qualified charity. QCD's can be counted toward satisfying your required minimum distribution ("RMD") for the year as long as certain rules are met.

In addition to the benefits of giving to charity, a QCD excludes the amount donated from your taxable income, which is unlike regular withdrawals from a Traditional IRA. Keeping your taxable income lower may reduce the impact to certain tax credits and deductions including Social Security and Medicare.

Here are the requirements:

- You must be 70 ½ or older to be eligible to make a QCD
- QCD's are limited to the amount that would otherwise be taxed as ordinary income.
- For a QCD to count towards your current year's required minimum distribution, the funds must come out of your IRA by your RMD deadline, generally December 31.

The key rule to remember is that the distribution must be made directly to the charity and not the owner or beneficiary. Distribution checks need to be made payable to the charity or else it will be counted as a taxable distribution. The owner or beneficiary can receive this check and deliver it to the charity but he or she cannot deposit the check and then make out another one to the charity.

You should always consult your financial advisor if you are thinking about a QCD.
