SHELLS LUTHERAN CHURCH FUNERAL POLICY

- 1. All funerals held at Shells Church must be approved by the Shells Pastor.
- 2. The liturgy for the burial of the dead shall be conducted in the Lutheran tradition.
- 3. All elements of the liturgy shall be approved by the Pastor.
- 4. The Shells Pastor shall be the presiding minister at all funerals unless he/she cannot be in attendance. Any other officiants or clergy serve only at the invitation of Shells Pastor.
- 5. The Shells Organist shall be the organist at all funerals. If a substitute is necessary, he/she shall be approved by the Shells Organist or the Shells Pastor.
- 6. All music to be included in any funeral that takes place at Shells Church shall be jointly approved by the Shells Pastor and Organist.
- 7. Bulletins for the funeral should be produced by the secretary of Shells Church after the contents have been pre-approved by the Shells Pastor.
