

SHELLS LUTHERAN CHURCH FUNERAL POLICY

1. All funerals held at Shells Church must be approved by the Shells Pastor.
2. The liturgy for the burial of the dead shall be conducted in the Lutheran tradition.
3. All elements of the liturgy shall be approved by the Pastor.
4. The Shells Pastor shall be the presiding minister at all funerals unless he/she cannot be in attendance. Any other officiants or clergy serve only at the invitation of Shells Pastor.
5. The Shells Organist shall be the organist at all funerals. If a substitute is necessary, he/she shall be approved by the Shells Organist or the Shells Pastor.
6. All music to be included in any funeral that takes place at Shells Church shall be jointly approved by the Shells Pastor and Organist.
7. Bulletins for the funeral should be produced by the secretary of Shells Church after the contents have been pre-approved by the Shells Pastor.
